Remember--your **cohort year** is the year during which you take the two-semester sequence of methods courses. **Prerequisites to the fall methods block:** admission to language arts cohort, EDT 190, EDP 201, EDL 204, EDT 246A, , evidence of computer competency by passing CSA 141 test (or successful completion of CSA 141), 21 hrs of content courses, 2.5 gpa (cumulative, education core, and in content courses,) 64 cr. hrs. earned

**Prerequisite to EDT 428-** successful completion of EDT 427, EDT 346 A, EDT 421A & EDP301A..
