

GERMAN POSSIBLE SEQUENCE OF COURSES

Apply for a cohort by the May, 2006 deadline. Among the criteria for admission to a cohort is that you must pass Praxis I. You should take Praxis I (also called PPST) as soon as possible. Go to www.ets.org for more information. Go to 404 McGuffey, late in the fall semester or anytime in the second semester for a cohort application.

Coursework indicated below assumes students place into and begin language study above the 202-level. Adjust this sequence if you begin your coursework at or below the 202-level.
