This is suggested list of material that will be used and/or discussed and demonstrated. Some paper and paints will be supplied for try-out. (Bring the supplies that you have been using; add to this list as you like). This list also includes the extra materials needed to work out-of-doors, weather permitting.

Art masking fluid (for watercolor)

One or two small jars with screw tops to carry dish soap and ammonia solution to clean masking fluid from brushes.

Brushes:

#5, #3, #1 Kolinsky sable

#7, #9 Kolinsky sable or synthetic

1/4" – 1/2" round (#12 or larger, white nylon)

Pigments: (tubes)

(Professional artist grade, not student grade)

White opaque

Cadmium lemon

Cadmium yellow, medium

Winsor red

Yellow ochre

Burnt sienna

Raw umber

Burnt umber

Ivory black

Chromium oxide green

Cobalt blue

Thalo blue

Ultramarine blue

Alizarin crimson

Paper: Two Arches CP W.C. blocks: 12 x 16" or 14 x 20"

Pencils: 2H and Ebony

Small natural sponge

Masking tape (1/2" – 1", non-acid variety)

India ink

Uniball vision micro marker

Water container – plastic, quart

Palette (with cover or closure)

Kneaded eraser

Favorite photos, color, family portraits included

Equipment for working outside:

Chair or stool, folding

Rain gear

Umbrella

Insect repellent

Shoulder bag or knapsack, ideal if WC block fits inside

Water bottle

Waterproof portfolio or folder for WC blocks and sketchbook

Pocketknife

Sun hat with brim

Optional items:

Additional pencils: 4B, HB, Conte, Sepia

Reed pen

White nylon ("white sable") brushes for masking fluid and watercolor: #1, #4, and #8

Oil painting bristle brushes for correcting: #2 or #5

1 1/2" bristle brush for varnish, hardware store

Brush carrier

Sketchbook

Previous artwork you may want comment on
