Please bring the following supplies to your workshop:

Safety glasses **REQUIRED**

Pen - notebook - sketchbook - ruler - scissors

Exacto knife

small natural sponge

small container Badger Balm

empty film containers

awl, or any pointed tool, like a darning needle

2 paint brushes, one fine pointed, one flat-edged

cotton hand towel to save on paper waste

a dozen old playing cards you don't want

emery boards and sanding sponges (med. coarse and med. fine) these are cheap and available at Sally beauty supply

favorite buttons, stamps or textures you want to use; I have plenty.

PVC surfaces and rolling tools - teflon sheets

COST OF CLAYS and KIT:

The costs of the metal clay market fluctuates daily with the current market price and the instructor will purchase the clays at her cost.

Presently 50 gms of silver metal clay costs **\$80.00**; bronze metal clay costs **\$25.00** per 100 gms

A basic kit will be provided for each student and will include work surfaces, stones to fire in place and sterling for earwires. This material kit fee will be **\$25.00**.

OPTIONAL ITEMS:

These items may be brought, bought, or borrowed** from the instructor:

olive oil and cotton balls instead of badger balm

color shaper

tweezers

embossing tool

humidor

tissue blade

linoleum carving tool

electric cup warmer

**You will be borrowing my used well-loved workshop tools; there will be a small amount available for purchase.

Torches will be \$75.00 if student wishes to purchase one. Ginger will be bringing several brand new PMC kilns for this workshop. They will be available for purchase at cost with complete warranty at the end of the workshop. Contact Ginger at 614-876-0068 if interested (first call basis).
