Jane & Dessie Rees Scholarship

Scope

Each year, the **Jane & Dessie Rees Scholarship** is awarded to at least one graduate student (full and/or part-time) in the department of Family Studies and Social Work. The department of Family Studies and Social Work awards this scholarship in the amount of at least \$1,000 (applicants need not be Ohio residents).

Eligibility

All FSW full or part-time continuing graduate students who plan to graduate in December 2007, May 2008, or August 2008; have an overall GPA of 3.0; and complete this application including the required essay responses are eligible to apply. This scholarship is competitive. Applications will be evaluated on the basis of GPA and essay responses. The Jane & Dessie Rees Scholarship application must be submitted by April 16, 2008 to be considered for this scholarship.

Scholarship Applications

Students who wish to apply should complete an application form available from the FSW department office located in room 101A McGuffey Hall. You will also need current transcripts (copy of DARS is acceptable), a resume, and responses to the questions specified on the application form.
