Elizabeth Caughey Stegmaier Scholarship Information

Scope

Each year, the **Elizabeth Caughey Stegmaier Scholarship** is awarded to one undergraduate student majoring in either Family Studies or Social Work. This scholarship is equal to the tuition for an Ohio student for one semester (applicants need not be Ohio residents).

Eligibility

All FSW majors who plan to graduate next December, May, or the following August; have an overall GPA of 3.0 and a 3.25 major GPA; and complete this application including the required essay responses are eligible to apply. This scholarship is competitive. Applications will be evaluated on the basis of a balance of academic achievement and essay responses. **The Elizabeth Caughey Stegmaier Scholarship** application must be submitted by April 15.

Scholarship Applications

Students who wish to apply should complete an application form available from the FSW department office located in room 101A McGuffey Hall. You will also need current transcripts (copy of DARS is acceptable), a resume, and responses to the questions specified on the application form.
