Miami University is pleased to announce the 2009 Research Experiences for Undergraduates (REU) Program, funded by the National Science Foundation and Miami University.

- 8 positions
- 10 weeks between May 18 and July 31, 2009
- Based at Miami University, in Oxford, Ohio.

This REU site focuses on collaborative research on the *Ecology of Human-Dominated Landscapes*. Students will be immersed in their own research projects that are part of a larger team of other students and faculty. Each student will receive:

- \$4200 stipend
- Free housing
- Travel to and from Miami University
- Funds to use for their research
- 12 credit hours, tuition-free and transferable



The program includes:

- Research opportunities in the field or lab
- Experience analyzing your own data and creating a platform presentation.
- Field trips to learn about ecological restoration and different ecosystems
- Short courses on ethics and professions in ecology and environmental science
- Seminars presented by visiting well-known scientists

Undergraduates with interest in ecology and environmental science from any institution are eligible. Prior coursework in ecology and/or environmental science is recommended and we prefer students that are entering their junior or senior years. Miami University is an Equal Opportunity Employer. Applications will be reviewed starting February 1, 2009.
