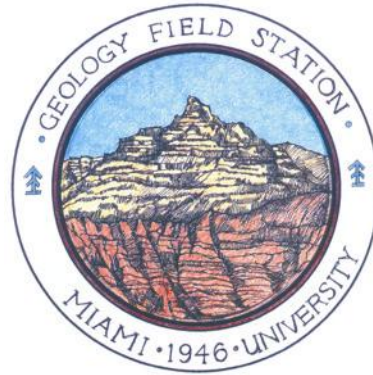

Spend two weeks camping, learning field methods, and mapping in the spectacular geologic settings of the Snake River Plain - Yellowstone - Teton region and the northern U.S. and southern Canadian Rocky Mountain region. The remaining three weeks are spent mapping in the Wind River and Absaroka Mountains while based out of Timberline Ranch, 15 miles northwest of Dubois, WY and 70 miles northeast of Jackson, WY.
