

MIAMI UNIVERSITY GEOLOGY FIELD STATION - 2010

TRAVEL INFORMATION AND INSTRUCTIONS

RENDEZVOUS

We will rendezvous in the Jackson Hole area by **3:00 PM, Saturday, June 5, 2010**. All participants must be present by this time.

AIR TRAVEL

Your arrival point is the Jackson, WY airport. Participants planning to fly should arrange a flight as soon as possible to insure direct connections and to obtain the best possible fares. Please pack as if you are going backpacking, luggage space will be limited! **You must arrive no later than 3:00 PM, Saturday, June 5.** If necessary, travel on Friday, June 4 and spend the night in Jackson, WY (please contact us for details). Commercial transportation is available between the Jackson airport and downtown Jackson.

Miami University vans will make frequent pick-ups at the Jackson airport (wait adjacent to the baggage conveyor) starting at approximately Noon on Saturday, June 5. **The final airport pick-up will be made at 3:00 PM, Saturday, June 5.**

All participants must vacate the Timberline Ranch facility during the morning of Saturday, July 10. **Please plan your departure from the Jackson airport for Saturday, July 10 anytime after 9:00 AM.** Vans will transport you from the ranch to the Jackson airport free of charge very early Saturday morning.

GROUND TRAVEL – PRIVATE VEHICLES

Participants planning to drive personal vehicles or to be dropped off should **arrive at Timberline Ranch (approximately 15 miles northwest of Dubois, WY along U.S. 26/287) between 11:00 AM and 1:00 PM, Saturday, June 5, 2009.** You will park your vehicle at the ranch. No personal vehicles will be used during the traveling portion of the course, and use will be limited during our stay at the ranch. **Miami University vans will depart from the ranch at 1:30 PM, Saturday, June 5** to arrive in the Jackson Hole area by 3:00 PM. Please do not arrive at the ranch earlier than 11:00 AM, Saturday, June 5. If necessary, stay in Dubois or nearby the night before.

The course ends at 5:00 PM, Friday, July 9, and participants driving their own vehicles may depart at that time. **All participants must vacate the Timberline Ranch facility during the morning of Saturday, July 10.**

GROUND TRAVEL – MIAMI UNIVERSITY VANS

Vans will depart from the Shideler Hall loading zone, located at the corner of U.S. 27 (Patterson Avenue) and Spring Street, at 8:00 AM, Wednesday, June 2. The trip will involve three days and two nights of travel, arriving at Timberline Ranch on Friday, June 4. The vans will travel along Interstate 80 much of the way.

There is **limited** space for participants to ride to and from the field station at a cost of \$50 (Student driver volunteers are exempt from this fee). Until final enrollment numbers are in hand, we do not know how much van space will be available.
