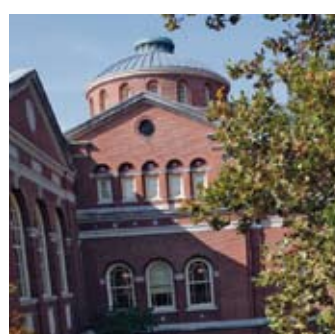

## Live

- On campus near classes
- In a Miami residence hall
- With other Junior Scholars

Junior Scholars live in an air-conditioned hall with a professional adviser and several Miami student staff members. Rooms are furnished with beds, desks, dressers, a telephone, a refrigerator, a cable TV jack, and Internet connectivity. Most meals will be provided in a nearby dining hall. Because the program is designed as a "living-learning" experience, Junior Scholars must live on campus, and cars are not permitted.



## Qualify

To be eligible, you must:

- complete your junior year in high school by June 28, 2009, and not graduate before January 2010
- have a grade point average (in most cases) of at least 3.5 in high school academic subjects or rank in the top 10 percent of your class
- submit an official high school transcript, along with test scores such as the PSAT, PLAN, SAT, or ACT
- submit certification of English language skills (e.g., TOEFL or letter from your English teacher) if English is not your native language
- be recommended by a high school teacher, guidance counselor, or principal

## Plan

The cost of room, board, and instructional fees is expected to be:

- for an Ohio resident, approximately \$2,500
- for a non-Ohio resident, add tuition of about \$950

The scholarship each student receives is included in these figures. There may be a moderate increase in program costs as university fees increase. An exact statement of program costs will be available after January 1, 2009. Also allow at least \$200 for textbooks. Incidental expenses for snacks, entertainment, and souvenirs will vary.

We will notify you of your admission status shortly after we receive your application and your transcript. If you are accepted, we will send registration materials and housing forms. Remember, early applicants may enjoy a wider selection of classes.

- participate in special programs of recreation, seminars, and social events



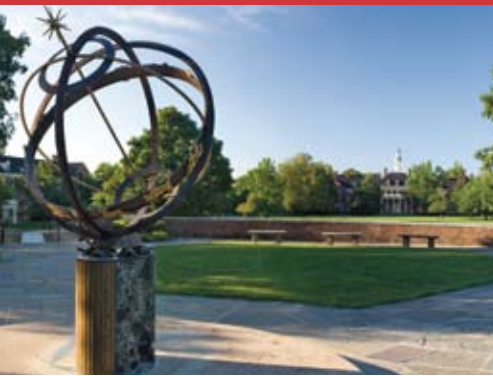
