POLICY BRIEFING – ALTERNATIVE POLICY OPTIONS

Present both a written and oral summary of your policy options. I expect at a minimum three alternatives. At this stage they do not have to be fully prepared. But they must have the following at least minimally considered.

- A – Brief summary of the problem
- B – Identification of the alternatives
 - 1) brief characterization of the components.
 - 2) how it will address the problem.
- C – Identification of the criteria.
 - 1) type of analysis
 - 2) why this criteria is important

Each group may have up to fifteen minutes to present your information. Time will be allowed for questions from the audience.

Remember to keep you statements brief and to the point.

Keep your presentations formal: relaxed is ok, casual (or nonchalant) is not.

Written presentations should be no more than two and a half pages of single spaced material (five, double spaced).
