

Short Writing Assignment

Richard Kohn's "History at Risk: The Case of the *Enola Gay*" describes the controversy surrounding the planned, and ultimately canceled, *Enola Gay* exhibition at the National Air and Space Museum. This assignment consists of **two** components:

- 1.) Please identify, summarize, and assess the arguments for and against the proposed exhibition presented in the text.
- 2.) State your own opinion on the decision to cancel the exhibition.

Note:

- You do **not** need to include any other course readings or outside sources.
- This paper is worth 20% of your overall course grade.

FORMAL REQUIREMENTS

The paper should be:

- 3 pages in length
- double-spaced
- written in a 12 pt. font
- stapled
- proofread

You need to:

- cite your sources and include a works cited page/bibliography. You may use any style of citation, but you must remain consistent.
- follow the writing suggestions posted on blackboard
- proofread your paper
- read very carefully the university policies regarding plagiarism (defined as "using another person's words or ideas without giving that person credit"), section 01.501 of the Miami U student handbook
