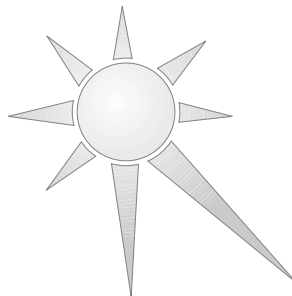
The Cathedral was built in the 13th Century French-Gothic style, and constructed of Indiana limestone. It features 82 hand-poured stained glass windows crafted in Munich Germany, including the 24 x 67 foot window in the north transept, one of the largest in the world. Enjoy the company of friends and learn about the play "The Seagull."

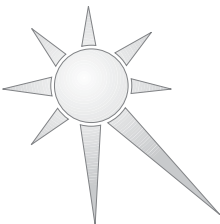

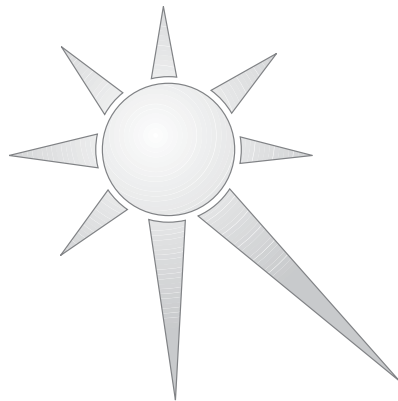

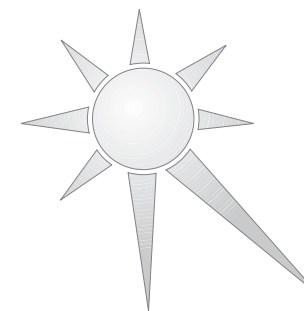
