**Item A7:** The Jumbo pass (for train and bus travel anywhere in the country of Luxembourg) is good for one year.

**Item B1:** The local travel agency, AAA Travel Unlimited, organizes an optional group flights that fly into Brussels, Frankfurt, Dusseldorf, or Paris. For the exact cost, contact their office (513-523-7555). Add any expense you incur getting to the US airport. If you wish to take the group flight, add the cost to get to its departure point. The cost of the charter bus from the airport to Lux (ea. \$45 one-way) is not included in the group airfare cost. The charter bus is also available to students not on the optional group flight.

\*\* Full year students need only attend the Luxembourg-based orientation in the first semester, so are only charged once.

\*\*\*Travel: This figure depends on the exchange rate and personal spending habits which vary greatly. Those students who travel the traditional student way, (youth hostels, sandwiches, few souvenirs) will have a low budget. Figure around 150 euros per weekend (50 euro for 2 nights in a youth hostel + meals + museums. Because there is more than 1 week of vacation during the spring semester, travel costs in the spring are higher. Full-year students tend to space out their travel and spend less per semester. Heavy spenders may spend close to \$8,000 (ex. those that go bungee jumping in Switzerland, skiing, travel to Finland to London to Turkey during one week of vacation).

\*\*Oxford students must provide proof of health and accident insurance. If you are not covered by another policy, you must buy the university-sponsored coverage. Please note the health insurance is listed for both semesters but it is paid in full the first semester for the academic year.
