

Information and Data Related to Animal Research Space at Miami University

1. **What is the amount of “research animal space” at Miami University?**

The animal facility occupies approximately 12,500 square foot of space. Miami has additional housing at the Ecology Research Center which is used primarily for temporary holding of animals during field research.

2. **What is the biosafety level of the “research animal facilities”?**

The facility is a biosafety level one facility. We are capable of handling biosafety level two projects should the need arise.

3. **What is the condition of “research animal space”?**

Miami University is completing a new research animal facility and should complete the transition by the end of January 2009. This is a state of the art facility which centralizes all of our university animal research, including aquatics, into one facility.
