Who should get a mammogram and why:

- ⌘ It is recommended that all women over age 40 have a mammogram yearly
- ⌘ Early detection of breast cancer helps increase chances of survival
- ⌘ Mammograms are the best way to detect breast cancer early
- ⌘ View the [Mammograms Matter Video Clip](#) of women's personal experiences with mammograms

Risk factors for breast cancer include:

- ⌘ Being a female over age 40
- ⌘ Family history and/or genetics
- ⌘ Menstrual periods that start early and/or end late in life
- ⌘ Never having children or having one's first child over age 30
- ⌘ Recent use of oral contraceptives or postmenopausal hormone therapy
