- Personal Statement. A brief 2-page statement explaining why you are interested in doctoral studies in social psychology.
- Three letters of recommendation from faculty who are familiar with your work and preparation for graduate studies. Ask your recommenders to write their letters on their own letterhead and give the recommendation to you in a sealed envelope with their signature on the flap. The Department does not have a separate recommendation form.

- Copy of your unofficial transcripts (Official transcripts must be mailed to the graduate school).
- Copy of your vitae or resume.
- Copy of your **unofficial** GRE scores
- An official copy of your GRE Scores will be sent to Miami University (Verbal, Quantitative and Analytic writing) The psychology subject test is not required. Final action on your application will not be taken until we receive the official scores from the Educational Testing Service.
