General Overview

As student affairs practitioners, it is imperative that we help create "citizens of the world" by employing a global perspective in our work with students. This international seminar is designed to provide both professionals and graduate students the opportunity to experience higher education in Europe through readings, discussions, and site visits. Over a two-week period, participants will travel to Germany, Luxembourg, and the Czech Republic visiting universities, meeting with and learning from administrators and students. Additionally, participants will have the opportunity to visit numerous cultural sites.

This course can be taken for graduate credit (3 credits) or as a Non-Credit Workshop earning Continuing Education Units. Enrollment is limited to 35; reservations are taken on a first-come, first-served basis.
